River News in Pompton Lakes and Pequannock

December 17, 2011– An article in the 12/13 Daily Record (see link below) details home buyouts along the Pequannock River in Pequannock. PRC has been a strong proponent of these buyouts as the best and most permanent method of keeping people out of harm's way. Applause to the federal government for providing the funding.

In other flood news, work was reported on the Pompton Lakes side of the Pequannock near Garden Road. This work is being conducted by the Borough of Pompton Lakes to prevent erosion from undermining homes there. It was authorized by the NJDEP as an emergency permit. PRC has already offered to replant this section of riverbank once it is stabilized to hold the bank and prevent future erosion.
